

OAA Survey System: QUESTION TYPES

Use **Radio Button** for single choice options

Use **Check Box** for multiple choice options

To enter a question:

- select the question type
- enter the main question header and click 'Add question' (lower down the page)
- enter text (towards end of page) for each answer option and click 'add option'
